This document provides guidelines relating to the use of the 'Tech Industry Gold - Accredited by TechSkills' logo and to the terminology to be used in copy in relation to the promotion of your Tech Industry Gold degrees or degree apprenticeships.

Background

TechSkills is the employer-led organisation which maintains the Tech Industry Gold standards and the accreditation of degrees and degree apprenticeships to these standards.

- IT Management for Business (ITMB) BSc Hons
- Software Engineering for Business (SEfB) BSc Hons

Note: degrees can carry any name provided they have been accredited as meeting one of the above suites of industry standards.

- BSc Digital and Technology Solutions Professional (BSc D&TS)
- MSc Digital and Technology Solutions Specialist (MSc D&TS)
- BSc Cyber Security Technical Professional (BSc CST)
- BSc/BA Digital User Experience (UX) Professional (BSc/BA DUX)
- BSc Data Scientist (BSc DS)



Logos

All programmes accredited by TechSkills as meeting Tech Industry Gold standards can carry the logo 'Tech Industry Gold - Accredited by TechSkills'.



Note: Always reproduce the logo from a master reference. It must not be redrawn, manipulated or altered in any way.

All master files are available from info@techskills.org in the following formats:

- > EPS: for all professional design software such as InDesign and Illustrator and for all professionally produced materials
- > JPG: compatible with all Microsoft software such as Word and PowerPoint
- > PNG: for digital applications.

When using the logo, please take into consideration the recommended minimum width and exclusion zone (as shown below). A clear space surrounding the logo will ensure no other elements conflict with the logo (50% of the Tick icon).

For print the logo should not be any smaller than 15mm wide and 120px wide for screen. This is only a guide; we understand the size might vary depending on format but always ensure the logo is readable.





The Tech Industry Gold logo should only be used in the colour ways shown above and below.

- 1 Yellow and dark blue (shown above)
- 2 Yellow and white
- 3 All white (on colour with a suitable contrast)
